Hermes joins the global battle for the reduction of carbon dioxide emissions

After the acquisition of the important accreditation regarding energy management, Hermes is proud to announce the acquisition of the ACA (Airport Carbon Accreditation) certificate issued by the ACI (Airport Council International) which is related to the joint efforts for the reduction of dioxide emissions, globally.

The ACA certificate concerns the first stage of recognition by the ACI and includes the approval by a certified auditor, of all the carbon dioxide emission data submitted to the ACI regarding the operation of the two international airports of the Republic of Cyprus.

In addition to the verification from the appropriate authorities for the submitted data, the first stage of certification ensured by Hermes, marks the entry of Cyprus airports in the international programme for the reduction of carbon dioxide emission, whilst at a later phase, it will allow the involvement of all the other companies and services operating at Cyprus airports who "produce" carbon dioxide through their operations.

It is worth noting that for the time being, the program and its requirements, have been managed to be met by less than 200 airports worldwide.

Overall, the ACA certification includes four stages of implementation and aims towards the development of collective efforts on an international level for the reduction of carbon emissions and environmental protection.
