



**ANNOUNCEMENT  
REGARDING THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE  
PANCYPRIAN FOOD COLLECTION CAMPAIGN  
“DYNAMI KYPRION”**

Hermes Airports would like to announce the commencement of the Pancyprian Food Collection Campaign named “Dynami Kyprion”. This charity campaign aims to collect food supplies to help people who need support.

This initiative is in essence the first public-private partnership of its kind as it has the participation of all the educational organisations, a large number of private companies and more than 1,000 volunteers throughout Cyprus. The campaign is being carried out in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture.

The campaign will last for one month, from November 20<sup>th</sup> until December 20<sup>th</sup> 2013. During the campaign three types of foodstuffs will be collected:

- a) Packaged legumes (lentils, black eyed beans, beans and chickpeas)
- b) Canned meat and fish
- c) Bottled olive oil

According to the campaign plan, the public will be able to assist in this effort by sending all or some of the specific food types with their children to the schools in the free areas of Cyprus. The schools’ administrators will then distribute this food to the families of their students in need of support. In case any school has a surplus, then volunteers will collect the food and transport it to the district warehouses which have already been established in all the cities of Cyprus. From there, if quantities are available, community markets, schools and other institutions would be able to procure the food items collected. If and when there are surpluses in rural schools, then these surpluses will be made available to the Community Councils.

The collection of food via the schools is not a new practice. It is already being carried out on a piecemeal basis in many schools around Cyprus. However, through this campaign we are aiming to create a comprehensive aid management model, on a Pancyprian scale.

Members of the public who wish to help but do not have children at school can do so by offering assistance directly to the local community markets. Companies wishing to support this endeavour can help by offering the requested food items directly to one of the district warehouses. In accordance with the campaign programme, deliveries of food to families in need of support can start either immediately or when the school administration decides that it has gathered the required quantities.

Beyond the target objective, which is the collection of food, the campaign also aims to foster ideas of altruism and solidarity. It also aims at affirming the determination of our people united to overcome whatever difficulties have been brought about by the economic crisis to our country.
