Hermes and the Special School of Saint Lazaros honor the International Coastal Cleanup day

Aiming to honour the International Coastal Clean-up Day, Hermes Airports and Saint Lazaros Special School, co-organised a coastal cleaning event in the vicinity of Larnaka International Airport. The successful event held, was integrated in the environmental initiatives undertaken by the Vantage Airport Group which is one of Hermes Airports' shareholders.

Apart from the children of Saint Lazaros Special School and the members of Hermes' staff, other volunteers from the airport community have also participated in the clean-up of the beach, including the Ground Handling Services company Swissport and the Cyprus Airports Food & Beverage.
